## SOME STATISTICS.

### 54,000 women...

...a year lose their jobs as a result of maternity discrimination

(EHRC, 2015)



### Only 3%...

...of those who lose their jobs as a result of maternity discrimination ever take their case to a tribunal. Just 1 in 20 seek advice.

(EOC, 2005)

### 85,000 women...

...are raped in England and Wales every year and 400,000 sexually assaulted.

(Home Office and Ministry of Justice, 2013)



### Just 15%...

...of victims of the most serious sexual offences report the incident to police (Home Office and Ministry of Justice, 2013). Many survivors never tell anybody what has happened.

### 1 in 7 female...

...students experience a serious physical or sexual assault during their time at university.

(NUS, Hidden Marks Survey, 2010)



### Of female students...

...who are seriously sexually assaulted at university, just 4% report it to their institution and just 10% report to the police
